Anyway, we do understand that everyone's circumstances are different, and that not everybody has the opportunity to enjoy the three sunny days of joy and fun that Mr Chiripón will provide us. Hence, you're absolutely free to choose when you want to come and when you want to leave. You can arrive on Friday and party a bit more, or you can arrive early on Saturday (but please, be on time for the games!). Regardless of your decision, please let us know by making it clear in the registration form.

With the player fee, you'll be provided with a 'chiripack' including accommodation, breakfast, lunch & water at the game fields, Saturday dinner, and tons of party. And please don't forget to let us know your special needs, suggestions, and comments via the 'Comments' field in the registration form.

What do I need to bring with me?

This is a list of things you must not forget

1. Something for your feet

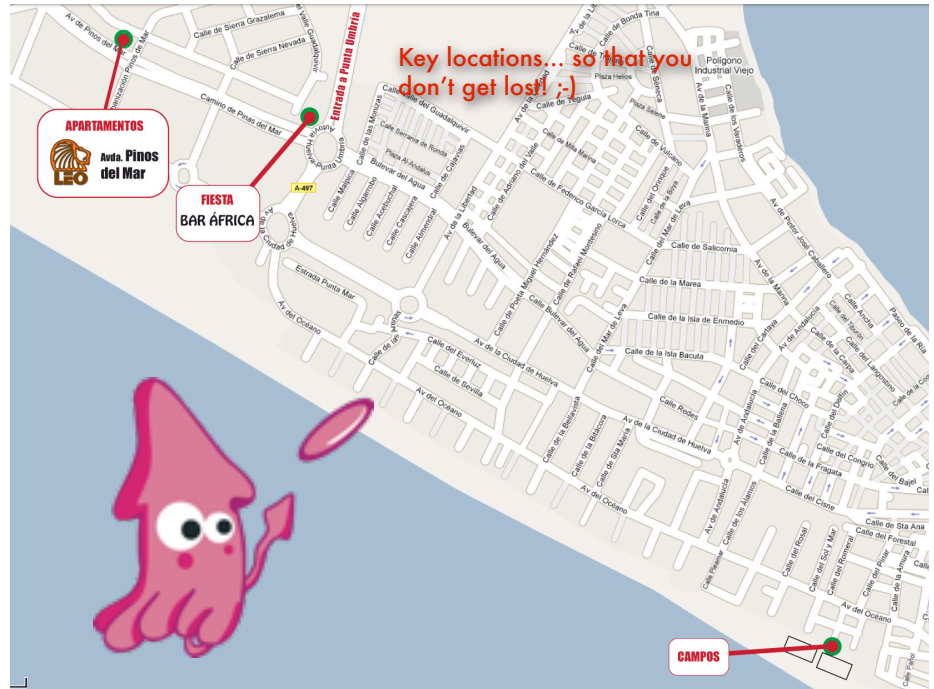
The sand in Punta is quite soft, but in December it may be a bit cold, and moreover there are a lot of seashells that might harm your feet. It's possible to play barefoot, but if your feet are delicate, you'd better wear some kind of socks.

2. Some warm clothes

We hope we can enjoy good weather the whole weekend, but hey, it's December, so it may be good idea to bring something to wrap you up warm if it gets cold, or something to cover you if it rains a bit for a while (not usual, but can happen).

3. The accommodation

You're going to be put up in apartments with a double bed and a double sofa bed, in groups of four people. You'll also have a fridge and a little kitchen in case you want to prepare something. There you'll also find bed linen, blankets and towels, so you don't need to bring them. Should you have any special needs, just let Frisbillanas or the hotel staff know in advance.



About Punta Umbría

Above you have a Punta Umbría map with marks on the main spots for the tournament:

- Top-left, **Apartmentos Leo**, in Avenida Pinos de Mar.
- **Game fields** just beside the Punta Umbría **Youth Hostel** ('Albergue' in Spanish).

Please mind the distance from the hotel to the game fields, which is about 30 minutes walking, 5 minutes by car. Frisbillanas will try to arrange enough cars to transport everyone, but in case you'd rather walk, please try to set off early to be on time.

The plan below shows the distribution of the game fields. As just stated above, the best way to find them if you get lost is to ask for the 'Albergue' location, as it is just beside them.

For your comfort :)

We'll take care of bringing food and water to the fields. There'll be more than enough for everybody.

Besides that, you'll already have a breakfast-pack in your rooms before your arrival.

Reception at LEO Apartments

Players will be welcomed in the apartments main hall. You'll need to identify yourself at the reception desk with a valid ID or passport, and you'll be given the key for your room. Frisbillanas will be there just in case you need something from us. Anyway, it may be handy for you to have some of our phone numbers, just in case: you can call Manuel (+34 615556171) or Elena (+34 652066992).

Before the games

We all like when games start on time, so it'd be nice if we were all prepared some minutes before each game.

You should bear this in mind when leaving the apartments toward the game fields in the beach, especially if you're walking to the place.

Punctuality, besides letting you enjoy the whole of a game, is a respect gesture toward the rest of the players of your team and the opponent team.

It's also highly advisable to warm up and stretch for a while before playing. We don't want you to get injured!

Dinner & Party

Dinner on Saturday is pre-arranged so that we can all have dinner together at least one day. For Friday night, If you need some help to find something in particular (italian, chinese food, etc.) ask for advice at the apartments reception desk, or ask a Frisbillanas member, and we'll be glad to help you.

Party, as last years, will take place in Bar África, near the apartments so that you don't have to walk that far after... well... we are all going to be really thirsty after so much running, aren't we?

Enjoy as much as you can, but please remember to be on time on the game field the next day ;)



And Remember:

You can choose to arrive on Friday evening or Saturday morning.

Depending on the number of nights you spend with us the price of the tournament will be different.

Have a look at the section "How much and how do I register" for further details.



How do I get there?

Well, it depends a lot on where are you coming from. From the next paragraphs, read the one that better fits your particular case. If none, read the 'Need further help' one.

Anyway, wherever you come from, you'll have to get to Huelva and from there take a bus to Punta Umbría, as this is the only practical way of getting there, so you need to read the 'Once in Huelva' section too.

From out of the Iberian peninsula

In this case, the first thing you should do is find the cheapest flight to Sevilla (recommended option), Faro or Madrid, and then, depending on the city you choose, read the appropriate section among the next ones.

We do recommend you to choose Sevilla as your connection because Frisbillanas will be able to help you there, maybe even to take you to Huelva in their cars, though we can't promise cars for everyone.

From Madrid

From Madrid you have two options to get to Huelva: train or bus.

By train, you'll spend about 3 hours and 45 minutes, and around 65€ (train called ALVIA, single ticket).

By bus, you have a return ticket for only 38,60€, but it takes 7 hours to Huelva. Check the SOCIBUS website for further info (link in the red box on the right side of this page).

From Faro

The only option you have from Faro is the bus. In this case, it will cost you around 20€ single, 34€ return. You can check the timetables through the links in the red box on the right of this page.

You can also check the information related to the buses between the city centre and the airport.

From Lisbon

From Lisbon, there is a bus connection to Huelva, but there are only two trips a day, so please check the timetable through the links in the red box in this page. The price of a single ticket is 43€, and 76€ for return ticket.

This bus is operated by ALSA, so you can also have a look at their website.

From Sevilla

From Sevilla, you can also choose between taking a train or a bus to Huelva.

By train, it will take 1 hour 40 minutes aprox, and 7.85€ (single ticket). Visit the RENFE website for further info.

By bus it's around 8€ (single), and it takes between 1 hour and 2'5 hours (there are several routes). Check the DAMAS website or phone them for further details.

Once you're in Punta Umbría, please go to 'Apartamentos LEO', where Frisbillanas will be waiting for you. To know more about Punta Umbría and the apartments' location, please check the section 'About Punta Umbría' in this document.

We have told you here what we think is enough to guide you on how to prepare your travel, but without making you feel dizzy with too much information. But it doesn't mean we can't tell you more details if you need them!

How much is it and how do I register?

How much is it?

It depends on whether you're staying one or two nights and whether you're a fast or a sleepy Chiripón:

FAST CHIRIPÓN REGISTRATION

- One (1) night (Saturday to Sunday) costs 55€.

- Two (2) nights (Fri to Sat and Sat to Sun) cost 65€.

SLEEPY CHIRIPÓN REGISTRATION

If you register from the 1st to the 10th of November, both prices have a 10€ supplement, so the prices are 65 and 75€ respectively. Furthermore, we can't guarantee that you have a spot if

you register within the 1st and 10th of November, so be fast and register NOW.

PLEASE NOTE: If you would like to stay more time in Punta Umbría after the tournament, let us know so that we can arrange a special price for you at the Apartments.

VERY IMPORTANT: in the transfer concept you MUST indicate CLEARLY the name of the player/s whose fee/s are being paid.

2. If for some reason you should register after the 31st of October, you would need to pay +10€ since the Fast Chiripón discount will not apply.

3. Registration is not valid unless payment has been received.

4. After November 1st vacancies are not guaranteed.

5. Cancellations are ONLY accepted BEFORE November 10th.
